RESOLUTION 2024-1

Resolution to Set Mill Levies

(Pursuant to 35-5-128, C.R.S. and 39-1-111. C.R.S.)

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2023 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE LIBERTY HILL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, COLORADO, FOR THE 2024 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the LIBERTY HILL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 20, 2023, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating, capital project, and bonds & interest purposes from real property tax revenue is \$109,711, and;

WHEREAS, the 2023 valuation for assessment for the LIBERTY HILL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT as certified by the County Assessor is \$15,450,160.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE LIBERTY HILL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating, capital projects, and bonds & interest expenses of the LIBERTY HILL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of **7.101 mills** upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable real property within the district for the year 2023.

Section 2. That the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, the mill levies for the LIBERTY HILL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT is hereinabove determined and set.
